



Crochet Amigurumi Parasprites

SUPPLIES:

- Yarn
 - Main Color (20 yds)
 - White (10 yds)
 - Black (1 yd)
- Crochet Hook (2 sizes smaller than recommended for your yarn size)
- Polyester filling
- Yarn needle
- 12mm Kawaii Safety Eyes, Felt, or floss for eyes
- Scissors



ABBREVIATIONS:

- ch – chain stitch
- slst – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet

BODY:

- Row 1 With Main color yarn, 6 sc in Magic Ring (6 sc)
- Row 2 2 sc in each sc around (12 sc)
- Row 3 [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times (18 sc)
- Row 4 [sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times (24 sc)

Add Safety Eyes if desired, between rows 3 & 4 about 5 stitches apart, and stitch on a smile.

Embroidered or felt eyes can be added if preferred.

- Row 5-8 Sc in each sc around (30 sc)
- Row 9 [sc in next 2 sc, then working in the front loops only, decrease by single crocheting the next 2 stitches together] 6 times (18 sc)
- Row 10 [sc in next sc, then working in the front loops only, decrease by single crocheting the next 2 stitches together] 6 times (12 sc)

Stuff firmly.

Row 11 [working in the front loops only, decrease by single crocheting the next 2 stitches together] 6 times (6sc)

WINGS: (Make 4)

Row 1 With White yarn, ch 11.
sc in each of the next 3 ch, then hdc in each of the next 3 ch, then dc in each of the next 3 ch. Work 5 dc in the end ch. Working in the opposite side of the ch, dc in the next 3 ch, then hdc in the next 3ch, then sc in the last 3 ch. Fasten off.

Connect the 4 wings together, then attach to body.



FEET:

Using black yarn, stitch legs on (or they can be tied to be more secure)



These are SO easy, they will multiply quickly... just don't let them escape!



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
