Crochet Wine Accessories



Supplies:

- Worsted Yarn
- Crochet Hook (size G/4mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- PomPom maker (optional)

Special Stitches & Abbreviations

• Magic Ring magic ring

• **BLO** working in the back loop only

• sc single crochet

rev sc reverse single crochet

dc double crochetst/sts stitch/stitches

• foundation hdc foundation half double crochet (optional)

Wine Bottle Hat

Row 1: ch 21, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch

across, ch1, turn (20 sts)

Row 2-20: Working in the back loop only (BLO), sc

across, ch1, turn (20 sts)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

To assemble: Fold the rectangle in half, with the ridges parallel with the long side, then stitch closed. This should leave you with a tube. Knot the yarn, then stitch around one end of the tube to gather the top of the hat. Add pompom if desired.

Wine Bottle Scarf

Row 1: ch 62 (or desired length of scarf), dc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across until the last st. ch 2 and slst into the final st. (60 sts)

Row 2: ch 2, working in the foundation ch (on the opposite side of your previous row, dc in each ch across until the last st. ch 2 and slst into the final st (60 sts)

Fasten off. Weave in ends. Position around bottle and stitch down with matching yarn, add tassels if desired.



Wine Glass Coasters

Row 1: Starting with a Magic Ring, ch 3 (counts as first dc), then 11 dc in ring. Tighten ring then slst in to of starting ch3. (12 sts)

Row 2: ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in same st, then 2 dc in each st around, slst in top of starting ch3 (24 sts) Row 3: ch3 (counts as first dc), 2dc in next st. [dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] around, stst in starting ch3 (36 sts)

Row 4: [ch 10, skip 11 sts, sc in next st] 3 times, ending in starting st.

Row 5: Loosely sc around, or reverse sc for a more finished edge.

Row 1: ch 30, slst in starting ch to form ring

Row 2: ch 1, [sc, ch 3, sk 2 sts] around, slst in starting sc (10 ch-3 loops)

Row 3: slst in next ch3 loop, ch 1, [sc in next ch-3 loop, ch 5] around ending with a slst in starting sc (10 ch-5 loops)

Row 4: slst in next ch5 loop, ch 1, [sc in next ch-5 loop, ch 3] around ending with a slst in starting sc (10 ch-3 loops)

Row 5-8: Repeat rows 3 & 4 alternately

Row 9: 4 sc in each ch-3 loop around, slst in starting sc For strap, ch as long as you would like, then slst to opposite side of basket. Ch2, slst to basket again, hdc in each ch, then slst to basket on starting side.

Fasten off, weave in ends.








Alternatively, you can use a foundation hdc to create the strap to the length desired, then slst to the opposite side.

Knit Wine Accessories





Supplies:

- Worsted Yarn
- Straight knitting needles (size 7)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- PomPom maker (optional)

Wine Bottle Hat

Row 1: Cast on 30 sts

Row 2-22: [K1, P1] repeat to the end of the row. (30

sts)

To assemble: Fold the rectangle in half, then stitch side closed to form a tube. Fasten off but don't cut yarn. Sew around one end of the tube to gather the top of the hat. Fasten off. Add pompom if desired.

Wine Bottle Scarf

Row 1: Cast on 9 sts

Row 2-7: K across (9 sts) Row 8: K1, P7, K1 (9 sts)

Rows 9-40: Repeat rows 7 & 8 (you can add rows here

to make longer)

Rows 41-46: K1 (9 sts)

Bind off knitwise.

Fasten off. Position around bottle and tack down with

matching yarn
