

TECHNIQUE: AMIGURUMI

Magic Circle

The Magic Circle allows you to have a tight hole at the beginning of your project, so that stuffing doesn't show. Perfecting this can take some practice, but it is well worth it.

X stitch vs V stitch

This makes a subtle difference on your project, but will make your stitches a bit tighter so stuffing doesn't show.

Seamless Color Changes

This technique is Important so that you don't see a jagged edge when changing colors while working "in the round".
