Crochet Dragonscale or Fairy Bag

Supplies:

- Yarn (80 yds) (Ferris Wheel works great)
- Crochet Hook (size recommended for yarn)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- (optional) Beads for cord

Abbreviations:

ch chain

slst slip stitch

single crochet SC

double crochet dc

st/sts stitch/stitches

increase (2 sts in the next stitch) inc

- Crocodile Stitch working in side of first dc, work 5 dc, ch1, turn to work 5 dc in 2nd dc.
- **Leaf Stitch** working in side of first dc, work 5 dc, ch 3, slst in 1st ch, turn to work 5 dc in 2nd dc.

Starting at the bottom of the bag,

Row 1: 8 sc in Magic Ring (8 sts)

Row 2: 2 sc in each st around (16 sts)

Row 3: [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next st] around (24 sts)

Row 4: [sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] around (32 sts)

Row 5: [sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st] around (40 sts)

Row 6: [sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st] around (48 sts)

Row 7: ch 4 (counts as 1st dc plus a ch 1), skip 1 st, [2 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc, ch

1, skip 1st] around, slst in 3rd st of initial ch-4 [36 dc, 24 ch]

Row 8: [Crocodile st (or Leaf st) on each 2-dc group, slst in each single dc st] around, slst in top of initial ch-3 (12 crocodile/leaf sts)

Row 9: ch 3, dc in the same st, [ch1, dc in center of Crocodile st, ch1, 2 dc in

single dc st between scales/leaves] repeat around

Repeat the last 2 rows 6 times or until the bag is the desired height.

Note: You can make the bag bigger or smaller by increasing or decreasing the number or rows here.

Adding loops for drawstring

Row 10: Ch 3, slst in each opening around the top

(repeat 2-3 times to finish off the top of the bag, or add in some Leaf Stitches if desired)

Drawstring (make 2)

Row 1: ch 100 (or until the string fits around the diameter or your bag)

Weave it through the loops created previously. If desired, add a bead to each string to make it easy to find, then slst to the beginning ch. Fasten off and weave in ends. When adding the 2nd drawstring, place the bead on the opposite side of the bag. Cording works great for this too.



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
