



Dragonscale Pouch



Supplies

- Yarn (Light Worsted #3 or Worsted #4)
Lion Brand Ferris Wheel works great
- Crochet Hook (size specified on the yarn label)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Beads for cord ends (optional)

Abbreviations

- ch** chain stitch
dc double crochet
dc-inc double crochet increase
inc increase
sc single crochet
sk skip
st/sts stitch(es)
slst slip stitch

Special Stitches

Crocodile Stitch - working around the post of the first dc, dc x 5, ch1, turn (working on the opposite side), dc x 5 in 2nd dc.

Leaf Stitch - working around the post of the first dc, dc x 5, ch 3, slst in 1st ch, turn (working on the opposite side), dc x 5 in 2nd dc.

Notes:

- This pattern is written in US terminology, and crocheted in the round unless otherwise specified.
- Stitch counts for each row are included in brackets () at the end of each row
(6 sts): 6 total stitches in the round
- Instructions enclosed in square brackets are intended to be repeated
[sc, inc] x 3: 1 sc followed by 1 inc, repeated 3 times

Bag

Starting at the bottom of the bag,

R1: In MR, dc x 12 (12 sts)

R2: inc x 12 (24 sts)

R3: [dc-inc, ch 1, sk x 1, dc, ch 1, sk x 1] x 12 (36 sts)

R4: [Crocodile st (or Leaf st) on each 2-dc pair, slst in each single dc stitch] around, slst in top of initial ch-3 (12 crocodile sts)

R5: ch 3, dc in same st, [ch 1, dc in center of Crocodile/Leaf st, ch 1, dc-inc in single dc st] around, slst in top of ch-3 (36 sts)

R6-11: Repeat R4 & R5, ending on an R4 row

R12: ch 3, dc in same st, [ch 1, dc-inc in center of Crocodile/Leaf st, ch 1, dc-inc in single dc st] around, slst in top of ch-3 (48 sts)

Adding loops for drawstring

R13: [sc in ch-1 sp, ch 3] x 12, slst in starting sc (12 sts)

R14-15: [sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3] x 12, slst in starting sc (12 sts)

Note: Adding picot stitches or leaves around the top can be a nice embellishment too

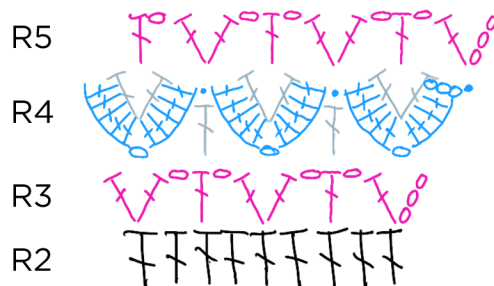
Drawstring (make 2)

ch 50 (or until the string fits around the diameter of your bag)

Weave it through the loops created previously. If desired, add a bead to each string to make it easier to find, then slst to the beginning ch. Fasten off and weave in ends. When adding the 2nd drawstring, place the bead on the opposite side of the bag.
